Accessibility inside the Manor House

- A staff member is required to operate all lifts.
- There are four manual wheelchairs available to borrow for use inside the house, on a first come, first served basis. This can be arranged with staff at the main entrance.
- For conservation reasons, many rooms have dim/low lighting.
- The floor surface inside the house is mainly carpets/rugs, with some wood flooring.
- The majority of the rooms have red carpeted floors, which can cause visual disorientation or sensory sensitivity for some visitors.
- There are no lavatories on route in the house. There is an accessibility lavatory near the Manor Shop.




