2 A Choral Feast of Song - a massed choir of over 100 voices
40 mins, 2pm Sunday only

Waddesdon Staff and Volunteers' Choir and Next Stage Choir in a combined performance of classic songs including You're the Voice, Hold My Hand and music from *Les Miserables*, under Musical Director, Russell Scott.

3 The JukeBoxes 30 mins
10.30am, 12.30pm & 3.30pm,

Watch two beautiful 1950s Jukeboxes spring to life as a pair of performers re-create classic pop music videos in a lip-syncing musical medley, with props, masks, puppets and terrible wigs.

4 Ragroof Tea Dance

3 hours of dancing from 2.45pm to 5.0s, glorious dance displays and dance classes. Everyone is welcome, no partners needed!

5 Captive by Motionhouse 30 mins
11am and 1pm

An exciting blend of dance, acrobatics and aerial work inside a large cage. Performed by Motionhouse Dance Circus Company, this show explores notions of captivity.

6 Harminder the Elephant
1 hour walk around shows at 10am, 12.30pm, 2.30pm & 4.15pm

A unique mechanically-powered giant puppet made mainly from recycled and found materials.

7 L_ve Hangman 45 mins
10.30am, 1.30pm and 3.15pm

A life-sized gameshow version of the pen and paper favourite. Guess the mystery words to win, but get it wrong and watch him swing!

8 Time for Tea, The Bullzini Family
30 mins, 12pm and 4pm,
Free workshop 1.30pm-2.30pm

Family friendly, tightrope and storytelling show based on classic tales from the golden age of ropewalking.

9 The Best of All Possible Worlds
30 mins, 12pm and 3pm

This new show premieres at Feast! A (very) loose adaptation of Voltaire's classic, *Candide*.
