## **Education Volunteer: Family Activities**

<b>Reporting to:</b>	Sarah Dewberry, Head of Learning & Engagement
<b>Based at:</b>	Manor
<b>Purpose of this role within Waddesdon Manor:</b>	To assist with the running of our programme of regular family events held throughout the year, particularly during school holidays
<b>Key elements of this role you could expect to undertake or be asked to do:</b>	<b>FAMILY EVENTS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Help prepare for family events, setting up of equipment and materials.</li><li>• Be prepared to be very hands on with busy activities and supporting the Education team throughout the day as and when they might need.</li><li>• Help provide supervision and safety of families of all ages and abilities whilst on site.</li><li>• Be willing to chat to parents and children during events.</li><li>• To help and encourage visitors of all ages and abilities to take part and explain how to undertake various activities.</li><li>• Cash handling- selling trails and activities</li><li>• To collect visitor feedback.</li><li>• To help with tidying up after family events.</li><li>• Attend briefing sessions on new exhibitions and season staff training sessions as required.</li></ul>
<b>You will be working with:</b>	Education team, other Education volunteers
<b>Who would be good at this role?</b>	
<i>We ask that all our volunteers have an interest and enthusiasm for Waddesdon Manor and the work of the National Trust. Particular person attributes needed for this role are: An enjoyment of being around and working with children and families. A calm, unflappable manner during a busy demanding event. This role does involve walking and standing. For all roles which involve working with children/or vulnerable adults we may request a DBS check. Essential (E) and Desirable (D)</i>	
<b>Presentation and Impact</b>	E Well presented, approachable.
<b>Education, Qualification, Special Skills</b>	D Previous experience of working with children desirable, although not essential. Interest in the history of Waddesdon Manor and sharing this with others.
<b>Work Experience</b>	D Previous experience of working with the public would be useful.
<b>Motivation and Aptitude</b>	E Reliable with very good time keeping.

<i>Disposition and Personality</i>	E	Positive, ability to relate well to all types of people, enjoy working as part of a team, good communication skills, confident in engaging with members of the public, enthusiastic about working with children.
<b>Training and Induction given:</b>		Shadowing of Education Team during education activities and informal workshops.
<b>Anticipated Time Contribution:</b>		Flexible. Increased days likely around school holiday times – February, May, October half terms, and August holidays for example.
<b>Lunch breaks and comfort breaks:</b>		Lunch break of up to 1 hour during special events.

### **Benefits of volunteering for the National Trust At Waddesdon**

After you have accumulated 50 volunteer hours you will be awarded a National Trust Volunteers card offering you the following discounts(subject to availability):

- Free entry into National Trust properties (or free entry for another person if the card holder is already a NT member)
- 20% discount to volunteer card holders on National Trust Membership, NT shops and restaurants
- 20% off in Waddesdon's Retail Shops
- 10% off in Waddesdon's Wine Shop
- 20% off most Waddesdon ticketed events (some exclusions may apply)
- Up to 35% off National Trust Holiday Cottages
- 20% off at National Trust's online shop

**Expenses:** Reimbursement of travel costs between home and Waddesdon Manor in the form of a mileage claim (33p per mile up to a maximum of 60 miles round trip).
