Purpose of this role within Waddesdon -:	Help out with our major events programme throughout the year- including all family activities, Summerfest, Chilli Fest, Halloween, Easter, Summer Programme, Christmas and make sure visitors get the most out of their experience. Based at :	Waddesdon Manor, various locations
Key elements of this role you can expect to undertake:	 Help prepare for family events, setting up of equipment and materials, tidying away at the end of an event Welcome and assist our visitors, helping to make their day enjoyable Help keep the event atmosphere engaging and welcoming Help and encourage visitors of all ages and abilities to take part and explain how to undertake various activities, to chat with parents and children during events. Be prepared to be very hands on with busy activities and supporting the team throughout the day as and when they might need Help provide supervision and safety of families of all ages and abilities Help our unique performers. Cash handling - selling trails and activities Collect visitor feedback regarding the event Attend pre-event and pre-season briefing sessions other necessary training sessions as required

Anticipated Time Contribution:	Flexible. Increased days likely around school holiday times – February, May, Summer months, October half terms, some bank holidays.
Lunch breaks and comfort breaks:	Lunch break of up to 1 hour during special events.

After you have amounted 50 volunteer hours you will be awarded a National Trust Volunteers card offering you the following:

- Free entry into National Trust properties (or free entry for another person if the card holder is already a NT member)
- 20% off at National Trust's online shop and up to 35% off National Trust Holiday Cottages
- 20% off in Waddesdon's Retail Shops and 10% off in Waddesdon's Wine Shop.
- Up to 35% off National Trust Holiday Cottages
- 20% discount to volunteer card holders on National Trust Membership
- Reimbursement of travel costs between home and Waddesdon Manor, at 33p per mile (up to a maximum of 60 mile round trip)
- We host events including an annual day trip, Summer picnic, Charity of the Year social events, Christmas lunch and coffee mornings so that our volunteers and staff can spend time with each other as a combined team.
