In the heart of the Buckinghamshire countryside, yet only an hour and a half's drive from central London, lies one of Europe's last remaining properties in *le style Rothschild*. Waddesdon Manor still offers today the very finest hospitality for which its creator, Baron Ferdinand de Rothschild, was renowned.

Waddesdon is proud of its range of unique venues, each with its own charm and appeal. From banquets to intimate dinners and exclusive wine tastings, team-building activities and product launches, this is an idyllic setting to give your guests an experience they will never forget.

### Windmill Hill

The facilities at Waddesdon provide a spectacular backdrop to a host of events, including product launches, annual conferences and international summits. The contemporary Windmill Hill complex is ideal for a more discreet experience, such as political gatherings or round table discussions.

### The Dairy

Overlooking a tranquil lake, this enchanting vaulted Victorian building, set in private grounds, is the perfect venue for exclusive entertaining at any time of year: roaring log fires in winter and summer evenings on the picturesque lakeside pavilions.

### The Five Arrows Hotel

A Grade II listed building in Waddesdon village, this quaint hotel is built on the site of an old coaching inn. It was originally used to accommodate the architects, craftsmen and artisans working on the Manor itself. Today, the hotel has 16 bedrooms, each with unique character, and a restaurant serving a varied menu with Rothschild wine from New and Old World vineyards.


